## Safe Driver Award Program\*

- complete one year of driving with no at-fault accidents;
- remain on your payroll throughout the entire recommendation period;
- operate a Nationwide Agribusiness-insured vehicle(s); and
- have been assigned to drive at least 250 days during the year.

Qualified drivers can earn annual awards, starting with a gold-toned lapel pin. **Safe Driver Awards** increase in value at five-year intervals to encourage continuous, consecutive years of claim-free driving.

## Motor Vehicle Report Program\*

According to the National Center for Statistics and Analysis (part of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration), more than one-fourth (27 percent) of all large-sized truck drivers and more than 20 percent of light truck drivers involved in fatal crashes in 2003 had at least one prior speeding conviction. In addition, seven percent and 11 percent of those drivers, respectively, had a recorded license suspension or revocation. A driver's history can often be an excellent predictor of future driving behavior.

One smart way to protect your business is to know your drivers. Our **Motor Vehicle Report (MVR) Program** makes it easy to get the facts about your drivers, and has the potential to save you thousands of dollars in uninsured losses.
